- 1. The Secure Act 2.0 was included in the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 (H.R. 2617). It includes many changes intended to enhance and facilitate retirement benefits. See the Legion article: here
- 2. The Major Richard Star Act applies directly to many of us Veterans that receive a disability and military pension. Your disability is DEDUCTED from your pay, to maintain the same amount of income. Your support is requested to lobby Congress to fix this inequity. See resolution (attached).
